Knock Shrine Living Christian Faith Series: Chaired by Fr Eamonn Conway DD. Thursday Feb 25th 'Living Christian Faith as Young Adults'. March 4th 'Living Christian Faith in the Classroom as Young Teachers'. Three recently qualified primary teachers explain how their religious faith is important to them and how it influences their work as teachers. March 11th Baroness Nuala O'Loan and Senator Ronan Mullen talk on 'Living Christian Faith in Public Life'. They will discuss their own faith, and the challenges people of faith encounter in the public sphere today. Thursday March 18th, "Living priesthood and religious life today".
