**Seeing Your Life Through The Lens Of The Gospel; In The Opening Verse:**

1. Jesus is portrayed as having a new sense of clarity about his life that enables him to set out on the road 'resolutely'. Perhaps there have been such moments in your life, moments of insight/clarity about the road ahead. Recall such moments/what they were like for you. 2. As he walked the road Jesus met with opposition. This angered some of his friends/they wanted to hit back. Jesus restrained them/would not let himself be distracted from the journey he was making. What helps you keep your goals in mind when minor annoyances distract you? 3. The response of Jesus to prospective followers seems harsh. He lets the first man know that discipleship is not a path to a comfortable nest. It is a way in which we never know what is going to be asked of us next. The disciple must be ready to move on. Where have you found good news in being open to change, confident in the presence of Jesus with you?
