- The celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation brings with it the gift of the Holy Spirit as a helper and guide on life's journey. It also involves a commitment to and involvement in the Christian community.
- The name chosen for Confirmation should be a saint's name. The reason for choosing the name is to take the saint as an example of faith and someone with whom the person confirmed can have a relationship through prayer.
- The sponsor for Confirmation should be a practising Catholic over 16 years of age. The sponsor is not normally the mother or father of the candidate but another person mature in faith chosen by the candidate, who, along with the parents or guardians, will support him/her in living as a disciple of Jesus.
- The dates given are provisional and may change even at short notice.
